For example:

The cat was happy with his milk, **although** the dog didn't like it.

This shows good feelings.

This shows bad feelings.

The path was becoming more difficult, **nevertheless** they kept going.

This shows a difficulty.

This shows determination.

Impact

Use them when you want to show a difference, or compare something.

Some connectives are interchangeable (you can swap them), but this does not always work. Always read to check it fits and makes sense.
