A conditional sentence is one in which one thing depends upon another. Often we use 'if', but there are others.

Conjunctions used for the conditional

**unless if provided  
so long as providing  
would & (verb)**

I **would help** you **if** I could.

**If** the weather is bad, we won't go out.

He will get a great job **providing** he works hard.

We will be there, **so long as** the train is on time.

**unless if provided
