- 1) Ask who like Scooby doo and play full clip

- 4) Character appearance – who is this?
- 5) Character movement – use adverbs. Begin with adverb?
- 6) Break in. Sentence starters, (onomatopoeia)
- 7) Describe the medal.
- 8) Peer mark work, suggest improvement.
- 9) Sandwich if time.
- 10) Ask for volunteer to read own piece.
